

Pilot Scheme on Quiet Renovation

To minimise noise nuisance to nearby residents during domestic renovation, the Environmental Protection Department (EPD) has rolled out a two-year pilot scheme to test out the application of quiet renovation in Hong Kong. Under the pilot scheme, quiet renovation equipment and good practices will be introduced through a series of seminars, site demonstrations, along with a free quiet renovation equipment rental scheme in order to raise awareness and promote the use of such equipment.
